COMPETITION RULES & REGULATIONS

GENERAL GUIDANCE

- a) There will be no practice ends prior to any game. Practice will be allowed before the competition commences.
- b) Matches are scheduled on the assumption of 30 seconds to deliver each stone.
- c) Teams should be prepared to self-umpire their matches in the spirit of the sport.
- d) In the knockout stages teams who are eliminated may be required to provide an umpire for a match in the next round.
- e) If your opponent plays the wrong stone or plays out of turn then you can decide to advise the umpire that you do not want them to claim a forfeited end and wish to replay the end.
- f) In Group games all ends shall be played.
- g) In Knockout games only play those ends required to establish a winner.
- h) It is each team's responsibility to ensure at the end of each game that the scorecard has been completed correctly.
- i) Please tidy up your own rubbish before you leave.
- j) Assistance would be appreciated with packing away stones and targets at the end of the day.

COMPETITION REGULATIONS

GBKA New Age Kurling Official Rules dated April 2014 shall apply with the exception of rules 4.e.1, 4.e.2 and 4.e.3.

Substitutions will not be allowed during a game but there will be no limit on the number of substitutions during the competition.

Stone bearings may only be swapped between ends.

Decisions of the two Chief Umpires shall be final and binding.

No Photography will be allowed at any time without the express permission of a Chief Umpire.
