GENERAL GUIDANCE

- a) There will be no practice ends prior to any game. Practice will be allowed before the competition commences.
- b) Matches are scheduled on the assumption of 30 seconds to deliver each stone.
- c) Players should be prepared to self-umpire their matches if they are able to do this, in the spirit of the sport.
- d) In the knockout stages players who are eliminated may be required to umpire a match in the next round. Unless indicated otherwise to chief umpires.
- e) If your opponent plays the wrong stone or out of turn, you do have the right to ask them to play again rather than claiming the end.
- f) In Group games all ends shall be played.
- g) In Knockout games only play those ends required to establish a winner.
- h) It is each player's responsibility to ensure at the end of each game that the scorecard has been completed correctly.
- i) Please advise the Control Desk when you leave the venue and when you return.**
- j) Please tidy up your own rubbish before you leave.
- k) Assistance would be appreciated with unpacking and packing away stones and targets at the beginning and end of the day.**

COMPETITION REGULATIONS

GBKA New Age Kurling Official Rules dated April 2014 shall apply and decisions of the two Chief Umpires shall be final and binding.

Stone bearings may only be swapped between ends.

No Alcohol shall be consumed in the Sports Hall.

No Photography will be allowed at any time without the express permission of one of the two Chief Umpires.
